Mark 16:1-7

I) THE EMPTY TOMB: (Mark 1-7) PP

A) The question was a great problem to the women. Who is going to roll away the

stone?

B) The stone was rolled away (vs. 4) PP

C) The angel did it (vs. 5) PP

1 Corinthians 15:12-19 in PP

II) THE EYE WITNESS: (1 Corinthians 15:5-8) PP

A) These eye witnesses are the most credible people, in that, they were willing to die for their testimony

B) The Passover Plot, a book written by a British biblical scholar, tells how Jesus planned his own resurrection.

C) All of these eye witnesses had their lives changed by this event. (vs 15:8) PP

III) THE MULTITUDE OF JESUS FOLLOWERS: (1 Corinthians 15:1-4) PP

A) The gospel has the power to change lives. (Romans 1:16) PP

B) Auguste Comte, a French Philosopher, and Thomas Carlyle, a Christian writer, had a meeting some years ago. Comte said he was going to create a new religion which would sweep away Christianity.

C) The followers of Jesus worship on Sunday, not Saturday. They celebrate Easter not Passover.
