WHY WORSHIP JESUS

1. JESUS IS THE GOD WHO ARRIVED IN A STABLE.

Luke 2:4-7

- A. When Jesus comes again it will be the grandest entrance ever made.
- B. When Jesus came the first time He arrived in a stable.
- 2. JESUS IS THE <u>KING</u> OF KINGS WHO WAS ANNOUNCED TO <u>SHEPHERDS</u>.

 Luke 2:8-11
 - A. Jesus, the King of Kings came to earth.
 - B. Jesus was born in a barn and was greeted by sheep, cows, and <u>shepherds</u>.
- Our God is a <u>Big</u> God for <u>little</u> people.
- Jesus is an <u>extra</u>-ordinary person who came for <u>ordinary</u> people.

3. JESUS IS THE <u>SAVIOR</u> FOR ALL WHO SEEK HIM.

Luke 2:10-11

- A. Jesus is the Savior.
- B. Jesus is the savoir for all who seek Him.

FOUR STEPS TO GOD

- 1. God loves us.
- 2. Sin separates from God and kills us
- 3. <u>Jesus</u> never sinned; He deserved life; He died bearing our sins; and defeated death
- 4. <u>Repentance</u> from sin and <u>faith</u> in Jesus brings us eternal life.
