Luke 10:30-37

## I. JESUS FEELS YOUR PAIN

Luke 10:33

- A. Like the Samaritan, Jesus was moved with compassion. Matthew 9:35-36
- B. Unlike the Samaritan, on the cross, Jesus was like the needy man in the story.

## II. JESUS COMES TO YOU IN YOUR BROKENNESS.

Luke 10:33-34

- A. Like the Samaritan, Jesus left the comfortable and crossed barriers to serve.
- B. Jesus came to us and became one of us so, He could relate to us. John 1:14-15
- C. Jesus does not offer us a religion, He offers us a relationship.

## III. JESUS WILL HEAL YOUR WOUNDS.

Luke 10:34

- A. Like the Samaritan, Jesus went out of His way to relieve pain and suffering. Luke 4:18, Revelation 21:4
- B. Unlike the Good Samaritan, Jesus heals our wounds by being wounded for us. Isaiah 53:3-5

## IV. JESUS MEETS OUR NEEDS

Luke 10:35

- A. The Samaritan invested time and money to meet needs.
- B. Jesus met all the needs in front of Him.

## V. PAID THE DEBT YOU COULD NEVER AFFORD.

- A. The Samaritan did for the man what he could never do for Himself.
- B. Jesus did for us what we could never do for ourselves - He paid for our sins. Romans 6:23 1 Peter 3:18
