Isaiah 9:6-7

I. WONDERFUL COUNSELOR

- A. Jesus is smart. Psalm 147:5
- B. Jesus is willing to share His wisdom with us. James 1:5

II. MIGHTY GOD

- A. Jesus is strong enough. Isaiah 40:28; Psalm 147:5; Jeremiah 32:17
- B. Jesus can be trusted to do the impossible. 1 Kings 1:37

III. EVERLASTING FATHER

- A. Jesus is the Father of eternity.
- B. Jesus provides eternal life. John 3:16; John 10:28
- C. Jesus provides a place of security. Deuteronomy 33:27; Psalm 90:1-2; Psalm 91:1-2

IV. PRINCE OF PEACE

- A. The Hebrew word for *peace*, is the Hebrew word *shalom*.
- B. Shalom is available because Jesus is the Prince of Peace. John 14:27; John 16:33; Romans 5:1
- C. Shalom is experienced when we actively trust the Prince of Peace.
 1. Trust Jesus as your savior. Romans 5:1
 2. Turn your problems into prayer. Philippians 4:6-7; 1 Peter 5:6-8; Psalm 34:4
 3. Keep trusting in Jesus. Isaiah 26:3
 4. Be surrendered to the Holy Spirit. Romans 8:6

V. KING OF KINGS

- A. Jesus is the King of Kings. 1 Timothy 6:15; John 12:12-15; 18:33-37
- B. Jesus will return to rule and reign. Daniel 7:13-14; Revelation 19:16... *On his robe and on his thigh, he has a name written, King of Kings and Lord of lords.*
- C. But we only experience the fullness of His blessing when we submit to the fullness of His authority.
