# "The Joy of Being a Part of God's Family"

Philippians 1:1-11

Wherever you go, you will see buildings with signs in front.

First Church, Community Church, etc. but the church is not a building; it <u>uses buildings</u>. The Church is not an organization; it <u>uses organizations</u>. It is not a program, although it <u>uses programs</u>.

The Church is **people** - people who have received their life from Jesus Christ, people who are sharing that life with one another, people who are extending the Christ-life to all those around them. Church is people sharing Jesus! Church is **God's** family!

## Three reasons why being a part of God's family brings joy!

### I. A CHOSEN FAMILY:

- A. We are called to be Saints, and we are called Saints. The word "saint" means **sanctified** one. And **sanctified** means to be **set apart** for God.
- B. Chosen family is a saintly family and a Holy family. A <a href="different">different</a> family.
- C. A chosen family is a Koinonia family.

#### II. A <u>CONFIDENT</u> FAMILY:

- A. A <u>confident</u> family who is mentioned in this text is the local church. In the New Testament, the word church is used <u>115</u> x's. <u>20</u> x's it is used in a general sense. To refer to the total body of redeemed, the saved of all ages. <u>95</u> x's it is used in a local sense to refer to a <u>local</u> congregation of believing people.
- B. There is only one church, one family of God. It is both <a href="mailto:visible">visible</a> and <a href="mailto:invisible">invisible</a>. It is both <a href="mailto:universal">universal</a> and <a href="mailto:triumphant">triumphant</a>.
- C. A confident family is one who believes God will
   <u>accomplish</u> in us and <u>complete</u> in us what He has begun.

## III. A <u>COMPLETE</u> FAMILY:

- A. A complete family of God is not about building buildings.
   We are about <u>building a family</u>! The trials of life are times of <u>growth</u> in the <u>family</u>.
- B. A complete family of God will demonstrate <u>family values</u> and stand out as living examples of <u>Christian love</u>.
