Researchers tell us that the last 12 months have been especially brutal on many struggling churches. The Church Answers Team tells us that several types of churches have died during the past year. Many churches with a vast majority of older members, churches with a history of division, churches that have neglected their facilities, the churches that refuse to follow pastoral leadership, churches in changing neighborhoods, and brand-new churches have failed to survive.

But thankfully, First Baptist is coming through the pandemic very healthy. Despite it all, we still have a consistent number of people joining the church and people are following the Lord in baptism. New leaders are stepping up and new life groups are being launched. Our Sunday worship attendance, although smaller than our pre-COVID numbers, is well ahead of the national averages for churches our size. Plus, we have developed a healthy online ministry that ministers to hundreds of people every Sunday.

MY VIEW FROM THE BACK OF THE PEW


"Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not turn from it."


NOTES OF APPRECIATION
