SIX BENEFITS OF SHARING YOUR STORY:

1. Sharing your story builds a bridge between what often seems foreign and inconceivable to lost people.
2. Sharing your story is an effective way to bypass intellectual defenses. People cannot argue with evidence of a changed life.
3. Sharing your story is often times effective because people love to hear stories, especially stories of victory.
4. Sharing your story is not restricted by a time frame.

5. Sharing your story is possible for both the spiritually mature, and the newly saved follower of Jesus.

6. Sharing your story takes evangelism (something so huge) and makes it personal, and relational.
