- 1. [] Be saved by faith in Jesus. 2 Peter 3:9; 1 Timothy 2:4
- 2. [] Surrender your entire self to God. Romans 12:1

- 3. [] Live under the control of God's Holy Spirit. Eph. 5:17-18
- 4. [] Serve God by doing good works. Ephesians 2:10
- 5. [] Stay sexually pure. 1 Thessalonians 4:3
- 6. [] Cultivate the attitude of gratitude. 1 Thessalonians 5:18
