## I. EXPECT TO HEAR GOD SPEAK: Exodus 3:1-4

- A. Moses ran away from Egypt, got married in Midian, and started raising a family. He gave up any plan to rescue the Hebrews.
- B. God had bigger plans for Moses and used a burning bush to get his attention.
- C. What is God doing to get your attention?
  - A restless spirit, a friend in need, or some unusual blessing He’s given you!

## II. LEARN TO LISTEN TO GOD’S VOICE: Exodus 3:5-10

- A. Listening requires submission in order to remove all distractions from holy communication.
- B. Submission is required to remove all barriers from our communication.
- C. Submission requires we must be attuned to God’s voice.

## III. PLAN TO OBEY GOD’S WORD: Exodus 3:11-14

- A. Moses was slow to obey.
- B. Obedience will automatically give you direction and purpose.
