I. DEATH IS A CERTAINTY. Luke 16:22, 26

- A. Death is an appointment we must keep.
Hebrews 9:27-28
- B. Death is the result of sin. Romans 6:23
- C. Death is a matter of separation. 2 Thess. 1:9

II. EARTHLY DECISIONS DETERMINE ETERNAL DESTINITIES. Luke 16:23-26

- A. Two Destinies:
 - 1. Heaven
 - 2. HELL
- B. Two Decisions:
 - 1. Dependency upon God.
 - 2. Dependency on something other than God.

III. ETERNAL REALITIES CREATE PASSIONATE EVANGELISTS. Luke 16:27-31

- A. The unlikely evangelist...
 - 1. The rich man became concerned about his family members.
 - 2. The rich man became a prayer warrior in behalf of his family members.
 - 3. The rich man wanted to do all he could to be sure they received a witness.
 - 4. The rich man was persisting in his effort.

...But he was too late.

He was too late to save his family.

He was too late to save his own soul.

- B. The wise evangelist
 - 1. Concerned
 - 2. Praying
 - 3. Witnessing and Warning
 - 4. Persisting
