II. <u>DEMONIC</u> FAITH DOES NOT SAVE (vs. 2:18-20)

A. Demon Faith is Intellectual. (vs. 2:19)

Demons Believe that:

- > There is only <u>one</u> God. (James 1:19)
- Jesus is God. Mark (vs. 3:11; 5:7)
- > There is a place of <u>eternal</u> punishment. (Luke 8:31)
- B. Demon Faith is <u>Emotional</u>. (vs. 2:19)
- C. Demon Faith is <u>Futile</u>. (vs. 2:20)

True Salvation is a matter of Intellect, Emotion and <u>Will</u>.

Tears without <u>Turning</u> is Tragic.

III. <u>DYNAMIC</u> FAITH DOES SAVE (vs. 2:18-26)
