THREE TYPES OF FAITH

James 2:14-26

I. DEAD FAITH WILL NOT SAVE. (vs. 2:14-17)

- A. Dead Faith Consists of Words. (vs. 2:14)
- B. Dead Faith Lacks Works. (vs. 2:14-17)
- C. Dead Faith is Worthless. (vs. 2:17)

II. DEMONIC FAITH DOES NOT SAVE (vs. 2:18-20)

- A. Demon Faith is Intellectual. (vs. 2:19)

Demons Believe that:

- There is only one God. (James 1:19)
- Jesus is God. Mark (vs. 3:11; 5:7)
- There is a place of eternal punishment. (Luke 8:31)

- B. Demon Faith is Emotional. (vs. 2:19)
- C. Demon Faith is Futile. (vs. 2:20)

True Salvation is a matter of Intellect, Emotion and Will.

Tears without Turning is Tragic.

III. DYNAMIC FAITH DOES SAVE (vs. 2:18-26)

- A. Dynamic Faith Involves the Whole Person (vs. 2:19-20)
- B. Dynamic Faith is Evident and Active. (vs. 2:18,20, 26)
- C. Dynamic Faith is Available for Everyone. (vs. 2:21-25)
- D. Dynamic Faith Produces Life. (vs. 2:26)
