"The Power of The Tongue" James 3:1-12

Proverbs 18:21 "Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit."

I) The Tongue Has The Power of <u>Perfection</u>:

- A) We can't avoid being a teacher, but we can avoid our <u>walk</u> being contrary to our <u>talk</u>. (vs 1)
- B) If we can learn to use our tongue <u>only for good</u>, then we can become <u>perfect</u>. (vs 2) (1John 3:16-18)

II) The Tongue Has The Power of <u>Direction</u>:

- A) The <u>analogy</u> of this power comes from bits and rudders. (vs 3-4)
- B) The tongue is capable of <u>divine</u> direction if we use it to speak the words of God. (Proverbs 3:5-6)

III) The Tongue Has The Power of <u>Transformation</u>:

- A) The transformation of <u>destruction</u> is an obvious result of an untamed tongue. (vs 5-8)
- B) The transformation that is <u>constructive</u> is obvious to the <u>Godly</u> tongue. (Romans 10:17)

IV) The Tongue Has The Power of Purification:

- A) The fact that people bless God and curse God with the same breath doesn't mean it has to be that way. (vs 9-12)
- B) The tongue has power to purify our <u>heart and spirit</u>. (1 Thes 5:16-18)
