# What does it mean to be a part of a church with an open door?

#### I. An Opportunity to Enter into the **Presence** of God:

Revelation 3:7-8

- A. Jesus is the Davidic Messiah. He has the authority and power to deny or grant access into the <u>presence of God</u>.

### II. An Opportunity to Bring the Lost to God:

Revelation 3:9-10

- A. This is an opportunity to serve with Christ.
- B. This is the opportunity to express Christ's <u>love for all</u> people.
- C. This is an opportunity to witness Christ's <u>climax</u> <u>of</u> <u>history</u>.

### III. An Opportunity to Achieve the Favor of God:

Revelation 3:11-13

- A. Abiding in God's presence, doing God's work will guarantee your favor with God.
- B. Your favor with God will <u>guarantee</u> your <u>rewards in</u> Heaven.
