I) The Holy Spirit Is Our Companion:

A) The Holy Spirit is a person, not just an <u>influence</u> or an <u>impersonal</u> power.

B) There are three characteristics which define <u>personhood</u>:

IntellectI Corinthians 2:10-11EmotionEphesians 4:30WillII Corinthians 12:11

C) The Holy Spirit is the <u>third person</u> of the <u>Trinity</u>.

II) The Holy Spirit Is Our <u>Helper</u>:

- A) "He will give you another Helper...." Other translations have the word, "paraclete" as Counselor or Comforter.
- B) "Another" in the Greek can be translated from two words: <u>Heteros</u> and <u>Allos</u>.
- C) The person of the Holy Spirit is identical to the person of Jesus. Therefore, the power of the Spirit in your life is to help you to live like Jesus.

III) The Holy Spirit Is Our **Teacher**:

- A) The greatest <u>teacher</u> in the world is the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.
- B) To teach is to <u>explain</u> a truth. To guide is to bring one into the <u>reality</u> of that truth.
