### "The Promise Of His Presence"

The Barna Research Group cites 4 specific reasons millennials have stopped attending church.

- 1. The church is irrelevant.
- 2. God is missing in church.
- 3. They are not <u>learning</u> about God.
- 4. They are not finding <u>community</u>.

## I) A Spiritual Revelation: (13-17)

- A) Knowing who Christ is comes from a revelation from the manifested presence of God.
- B) We don't just <u>learn</u> to confess Jesus as the Son of God, we are empowered to confess Him.

# II) A Supernatural Faith: (18)

A) People find <u>faith</u> when they are with people who have faith.

B) There are different ways to worship. <u>Aesthetic</u>, <u>Theological</u>, <u>Liturgical</u>, <u>Relational</u>, and <u>Emotional</u>. But there is only one faith.

## III) A Transformed Character: (18)

- A) The word in the New Testament for church is ekklesia which means the <u>called out ones</u>.
- B) In 1844, H.L. Hastings visited the Fiji Islands. He found you could buy a <u>human being</u> for \$7.00 or one musket. That was cheaper than a cow, but years later he returned. The value of <u>human life</u> had risen tremendously not \$7, not even 7 million dollars.

#### IV) A Vital Community: (19)

- A) The keys of the kingdom have to do with gatekeepers.
- B) On the day of Pentecost the early church saw 3000 souls saved and they <u>continued</u> <u>steadfast</u> in the <u>apostles fellowship</u>.
