- C. The Passover Determined Either Deliverance or Destruction. Exodus 12:12-13; Exodus 12:21-23
- D. The Passover Was to be an Everlasting Ordinance for the Jews. Exodus 12:14,17

- E. Crushed the Pride of Pharaoh and Freed Israel. Exodus 12:29-30, 31-32,36
