"YOUR GOD IS TOO SMALL"

Isaiah 46:9-13

"Your God is altogether too <u>human</u>," wrote Luther to the famous Renaissance humanist scholar Erasmus. I feel certain the great Dutch scholar was greatly offended at such an accusation, but history and a casual investigation of Scripture reveal the accusation to be <u>true</u>. In our day, J.B. Phillips has hurled the same accusation at humankind in the title of his book *Your God is <u>Too Small</u>*. (D. James Kennedy)

What does is mean for God to be sovereign?

PP-Isaiah 46:9

I. GOD <u>RULES</u> OVER HIS ENTIRE CREATION!

- A. Any consideration of a deity that is real must be dismissed and rejected. Jehovah God does not share <u>one part of His rule</u> in the universe with any other deity.
- B. The devil does have power but his power is not equal with God's power. Some teachers will tell you there is a good god and an evil god in the Bible. Such a notion would imply <u>dualism</u>.
- C. We don't need to <u>fear</u> the devil if we have our faith in God. We don't need to be <u>tempted</u> by the devil if we surrender our life to God.

II. GOD <u>REIGNS</u> OVER THE PAST, PRESENT, AND FUTURE!

PP-Isaiah 46:10,11

- A. Only a sovereign God can announce the <u>end</u> from the <u>beginning</u>.
- B. How then does free will work into God's plan? Man is free. Man has a free will. Man is free to choose.Free to do as he <u>wants</u>. Not free to do as he <u>ought</u>.
- C. "Perhaps a homely illustration might help us to understand. An <u>ocean liner</u> leaves New York bound for Liverpool. Its destination has been determined by proper authorities. Nothing can change it. This is at least a faint picture of <u>sovereignty</u>." A.W. Tozer

III. GOD'S <u>REGIME</u> BRINGS SALVATION BY GRACE!

PP-Isaiah 46:12,13

- A. Salvation never depends on man. It is always the work of God and the Gift of God.
- B. God's salvation is available to every man. But only through Jesus Christ.
- C. Will He save you? God is <u>sovereign</u>. God is not willing that any would perish.
