"Don't be Afraid to Draw Near"

"Drawing near is not a <u>physical</u> act. It's not building a tower of <u>Babel</u> by our own achievement to get to heaven. It's not necessarily going to a <u>church</u> building or walking to an <u>altar</u> at the front. It is an invisible act of the <u>heart.</u> You can do it while <u>standing</u> absolutely still, or <u>lying</u> on a hospital bed, or while <u>sitting</u> in a pew listening to a sermon.

Drawing near is not moving from one place to another. It is the directing of the <u>heart</u> into the presence of God who is as distant as the Holy of Holies in heaven, and yet as near as the door of faith. He is commanding us to come. To approach Him, to draw near to Him."

I. TO HEAR HIS VOICE:

- A. Why is it when we speak to God, we call it praying, but when God speaks to us we are said to be schizophrenic??
- B. God <u>shouts</u> in our pleasurers, but He <u>whispers</u> in our pain." C.S. Lewis

III. TO <u>FACE</u> HIS JUDGMENTS:

- A. The hair white like wool and His eyes as flaming fire is the picture of the **judgment** of **sin** in the world.
- B. "The fire of God is the opposite of its earthly counterpart. The closer you get to physical fire the hotter it is. But the further we get from the fire of God's righteousness, the more it burns in your conscience."
